<b>Curriculum Subjects</b>	<b>Literacy</b> Art & Design	
<b>Learning Objectives</b>	Design and create an Adventure Diary Write about a holiday. Do a presentation about a holiday. This activity is part 2 of 5 lessons exploring geography.

<b>Teacher Prep</b>		<b>Pupil Prep</b>
Give each child a blank note book or drawing pad.		Bring in photos of a holiday if they have some.
<b>Lesson</b>		
<p><b>Colour</b> Ask the pupils to decorate the front cover of their note book to create an Adventure Diary. Use BICKIDS® PLASTIDECOR Crayons to colour the images on the <b>Worksheet</b>. Then cut and stick onto the diary. Encourage the children to draw their own designs too.</p> <p><b>Write</b> Ask the pupils to write about a holiday they've taken with their family. BIC® CRITERIUM® HB pencils are perfect for this task. If they haven't been on holiday suggest writing a short story about a place they would like to visit. There should be at least 3 paragraphs written in first person and be in past tense. Add the holiday photos by sticking them into the diary. They can also draw pictures.</p> <p><b>Present</b> Select a few willing pupils to read out extracts from their diary to the rest of the class.</p>		
<b>Learning Outcomes</b>	Colour, cut and stick holiday icons onto the front of a diary. Write 3 paragraphs in first person and past tense. Present a story in front of the class.
