Lesson		
<p>Worksheet Cut out all of the pieces including the girl.</p> <p>Task 1 Using BICKIDS® KID COULEUR® felt tip pens ask the children to draw a winter scene. It must be drawn to the same scale as the girl on the worksheet. Put them in small groups if necessary. Encourage them to plan and discuss their ideas before starting.</p> <p>Task 2 Ask the pupils to write a short story about the girl doing something in the winter which is inspired by a real event. Encourage them to discuss their ideas first. When complete select a few pupils to read their stories out to the rest to the class.</p> <p>Task 3 (Optional) Using the short story, animate the girl in front of the winter scene.</p> <p>Need help getting started with animation? Learning Outcomes	Write sentences by planning and saying out loud what they are going to write about. Draw and write about a real event. Optional: Use IT equipment to create an animation.
